### OBJECTIVE

California, Here I Come! is a two and a half hour historical journey through *Disney California Adventure™* Park led and taught by a Disney facilitator. Students uncover what they have learned in the classroom including the four regions of California, Native Americans, the Gold Rush and California Missions. They also look at important figures in California history such as Chuck Yeager, Howard Hughes, John Muir and Walt Disney. Throughout this journey students will get to discover the Redwood Creek Challenge Trail. Explore the people, events, hopes and dreams that have shaped California in the Golden Dreams movie. The students finish their journey by *Soarin' Over California*.

- Discuss three famous aviators of California history
- Point out the four regions of California on a map
- Compare and contrast Immigration and Migration

- Explore and share their hopes and dreams
