Happy Holidays from the *Disneyland®* Resort Grad Nite team -

Before we head into the busy holiday season, please take note of the following information:

CHAPERONE CELL PHONE INFORMATION & GROUP ARRIVAL DETAILS

Beginning in March 2017, the main contact for each registered Grad Nite school will be responsible for submitting a minimum of two (2) day-of event Chaperone cell phone numbers that will be used by *Disneyland®* Resort Cast Members in case of an emergency or other incidents that may occur (i.e.: lost ticket or wristband) during your school's visit. This information must be submitted using our information collection site no later than 3 weeks before your event date so please plan ahead!

Using the same information collection site, the main contact will also be responsible for sharing the school's anticipated arrival details. Groups may arrive as early as *Disneyland®* Park and *Disney California Adventure®* Park opening. Park hours will be available on Disneyland.com approximately 6 weeks prior to your event date so be sure to plan accordingly as park opening times may vary.

All groups must arrive together through our Grad Nite security screening entry point via school bus, charter bus, or chaperone driven vehicles. If your group is staying at a local hotel and planning to walk to the Grad Nite security screening entry point. Additional arrival details and specifics will be provided at a later date. Reminder that under no circumstance may a student drive him/herself to Grad Nite. No exceptions.

ESPN ZONE POST GRAD NITE BREAKFAST ADD-ON OPTION

Continue the celebration after the *Disneyland®* Resort Grad Nite event with a hot breakfast at *ESPN Zone* restaurant in the *Downtown Disney®* District from 2 a.m. - 5 a.m. Grad Nite groups may also add unlimited arcade game play (for an additional fee) in the Sports Arena to keep the fun going until the morning. Post Grad Nite breakfast add-on options start at \$20 per graduate. A minimum of 150 graduates is required to book a Post Grad Nite breakfast at *ESPN Zone* restaurant.
