Greetings from the *Disneyland*® Resort Grad Nite team -

We hope you're having a great 2017 so far! In just a couple of weeks on Wednesday, February 22 at 9am (PST) we will officially open the online ticket store so groups may order their event tickets and submit payment. A link to the online ticket store will be emailed from DLR.WDTC.Ticket.Sales.and.Service@disney.com to the main contact. Please make sure this email address is not blocked by your spam filter or firewall.

Acceptable forms of payment include an organizational check with the address pre-printed, money order or cashier's check drawn from a US bank, credit card, or Disney Gift Card. If your group is paying by organizational check, money order or cashier's check, payment must arrive within 5 working days after submitting a ticket order via the online ticket store. Please make organizational checks, money orders or cashier's checks payable to **Disney Destinations, LLC** and send via FedEx, UPS or US Postal Service to:

NEW! - DRESS CODE GUIDELINES & PROHIBITED ITEMS LIST

Please carefully review the attached dress code guidelines and Grad Nite prohibited items list with your chaperones, parents of high school seniors and students planning to attend Grad Nite.

CHAPERONE CELL PHONE INFORMATION & GROUP ARRIVAL DETAILS

Next month, the main contact for each registered Grad Nite school will be responsible for submitting a minimum of two (2) day-of event Chaperone cell phone numbers and their group's arrival details. All groups must arrive together through our Grad Nite security screening entry point via school bus, charter bus, large vans, or chaperone driven vehicles. If your group is staying at a local hotel and planning to walk to the Grad Nite screening entry point, you may note this on the collection site as well. Walking path details will be provided at a later date. Under no circumstance may a student drive him/herself to Grad Nite.
