What is *Disney Performing Arts OnStage*?

Student and community performing groups of 10 or more are given the opportunity to perform onstage for approximately 25 minutes at select locations throughout *Walt Disney World Resort*.

Who can participate?

Any group of youth (ages 7+) or adult performers. Groups must **apply and meet audition qualifications**. Past performing groups have included marching, concert and jazz bands; show and jazz choirs; orchestras; dance and drill teams; color guards; pom squads; performance groups from dance studios; community orchestras; vocal ensembles; and gospel choirs. Available to international ensembles and groups.

Are there educational opportunities?

Disney Performing Arts Workshops offer the ultimate educational experience, and have been recognized by the National Association for Music Education, which officially endorses *Disney Performing Arts OnStage Performances* and Workshops.

When are performances available?

Performances are available daily throughout the year. Performances can be scheduled anytime during the day or evening, based on availability. **Apply a year out for best availability.**

Is Theme Park admission required to perform?

All performers and workshop participants are required to purchase one of the *Disney Performing Arts OnStage Ticket Packages*. Tickets will be valid for use only during the group's stay. A performance or workshop requires the use of one Theme Park admission on that day (excluding performances at the Waterside Stage at *Downtown Disney® Marketplace*), however your group can also enjoy the Theme Parks before and after your performance or workshop event.

May additional family members purchase tickets with the performing group?

You are able to purchase the *Disney Performing Arts OnStage Ticket Packages* for all additional Guests (chaperones, parents, siblings, etc.) at the same performer rate.

HOW TO SIGN UP FOR DISNEY PERFORMING ARTS ONSTAGE

1. Group identifies several performance date options and/or workshops.
2. Each group applying to perform prepares a nonreturnable audition video and a nonreturnable color photograph (8 x 10 or smaller) of the uniforms/costumes to be worn during their performance.
3. Travel Planner/Agent completes and submits all application materials 12 to 2 months prior to the requested performance date of the group. (*Disney Performing Arts OnStage* performances are limited during peak periods.)
4. The *Disney Performing Arts OnStage* team reviews the application and audition materials and notifies the Travel Planner of the group's status and/or performing date.
5. Once the group is accepted, the Travel Planner and director will be notified of their performance date.
6. Travel Planner submits completed Ticket Order with final payment at least six weeks prior to arrival.

Note: A minimum of 10 performers is required.

What are Disney Performing Arts Workshops?

Virtually any type of performing group, from pom squads to choirs and bands to dance teams, can hone their skills as they take part in magnificent behind-the-scenes workshops. All workshops are facilitated by Disney professionals and expose groups to real-world, professional rehearsing and performing environments.

When are Workshops available?

Workshops are available WITHOUT a performance experience (Ticket Packages plus Workshop Fees are additional). Workshops are 1.5–2.5 hours long. Available to international ensembles and groups.

Disney Auxiliation	Auxiliary units, pom squads and color guards Ages 11 and up	20*	Provides the unique opportunity to rehearse and perform an original Disney-style production. Raise the quality of the group's spinning abilities by focusing on proper technique, warm-ups, stage presence and the complete understanding of their equipment.
Disney Dancin'	Dance studios and dance teams Ages 11 and up	20*	Emphasizes the importance of discipline, show presentation and movement. Participants put this insight into action as they learn an actual Disney production number for a backstage performance.

HOW TO APPLY FOR FESTIVAL DISNEY

1. Complete the *Festival Disney* registration form.
2. Select the appropriate Ensemble Division, Classification and Adjudication Status.
3. Submit your *Festival Disney* Application Form along with a \$100 nonrefundable registration fee for each participating ensemble to the address below, or register online:

4. All registration forms are reviewed and groups are scheduled based on ensemble classification and student crossover considerations. Every attempt is made to accommodate requested dates.
5. All scheduled groups receive a *Festival Disney* Handbook detailing final arrangements.
6. Final schedules are sent six weeks prior to the event.

*Special awards are provided to individuals in certain categories at the adjudicator's discretion.

What is *Festival Disney*?

Festival Disney is a series of competitive performance events.

Who can participate?

Middle, junior and senior high school concert and marching (parade) bands, string orchestras, chamber orchestras, full orchestras, jazz and choral ensembles, show choirs and auxiliary units. Available to international ensembles and groups. **No audition is required.**

Where are the performances held?

Performance venues include *Disney's Saratoga Springs* Resort Performance Hall and the Premiere Theater at *Disney's Hollywood Studios*®.

Is this a competition?

Yes, although participating groups may choose to participate in a noncompetitive status.

What is the award structure?

All participating ensembles receive a *Festival Disney* Award and every member of the ensemble receives a *Festival Disney* medal. Within each division and classification, a "Best in Class" ensemble is selected (e.g., the top High School Concert Band in Class A or a Middle School Mixed Choir). *The three highest-rated ensembles within each category, regardless of classification, are recognized with Gold, Silver and Bronze Awards. Awards are presented based on criteria outlined in the *Festival Disney* application information.

Are there educational opportunities?

A top panel of adjudicators provides written and verbal feedback in all categories and conducts personalized feedback clinics for each concert group.

Festival Disney occurs on select weekends from March through May, and culminates each Saturday evening with a special *Festival Disney* Awards Ceremony in a *Walt Disney World* Theme Park.

What is *Disney Performing Arts OnStage*?

Student performance groups like bands, orchestras, vocal groups, theatre groups and dance/drill ensembles (minimum of 15 performers) can showcase their best in a 30-minute stage performance at the *Disneyland*® Resort. Marching bands (minimum of 50 performers with at least 40 musicians) can perform along the world-famous *Disneyland*® Park parade route, or the Performance Corridor at *Disney California Adventure*® Park.

Are there educational opportunities?

Yes. Our workshops open up the world of the *Disneyland*® Resort entertainer for students in these innovative hands-on sessions. Our workshops have been endorsed by the National Association for Music Education for meeting specific content standards as established in the National Standards for Arts Education.

How do groups sign up for *Disney Performing Arts OnStage*?

1. Please visit us online at DisneyPerformingArts.com to apply directly online or to download your application.
2. The group director must complete and sign one application for each group he or she intends to bring. The group must also send a recent audition videotape or DVD and color photograph of the group in their performance costumes with the application. The application will not be processed without the audition materials. All materials should be sent to *Disney Performing Arts* at least 2 months prior to the group's arrival date.

3. The group will be notified of their acceptance status in writing within 14 days of *Disney's* receipt of all audition materials. Groups are booked on a first-come, first-served basis.
4. Groups accepted receive a complete event confirmation kit containing all necessary information for their event(s). Travel planners receive a copy of the proposed itinerary and package ordering information. Please be sure performers participating with multiple groups and/or multiple events (performances and/or workshops) are accounted for in the group's itinerary and ticket order. *Disney Performing Arts* events may be scheduled at any time during the day. Your group may be required to arrive at the *Disneyland*® Resort prior to the scheduled park opening. Please do not schedule arrivals, departures or other events on this day. Please contact *Disney Performing Arts* as soon as possible if there are any conflicts with the group's travel or other non-*Disney* itinerary.

5. After sending the necessary confirmation paperwork, the group director should contact *Disney Performing Arts* three weeks prior to the group's arrival to discuss specific details regarding the group's event(s) at the *Disneyland*® Resort. Travel Planners/Agents will be sent a summary of the group's confirmation via email after the group director has called. Please contact *Disney Performing Arts* with any questions or concerns.

- *Disney Performing Arts* activities are subject to availability due to the complex entertainment schedule at the Resort. Events and activities may be scheduled by the *Disneyland*® Resort anytime during Park operating hours.
- One chaperone for every 10 participants will be given a complimentary *Disney Performing Arts* ticket. Other Guests are eligible to purchase *Disneyland*® Resort Theme Park tickets at special group rates.
- Performers must be at least 7 years old. *Disney Performing Arts* packages must be purchased for participation in all programs.

DANCE WORKSHOPS

Dance 101 & Dance 201

Led by professional show directors and choreographers, these 90-minute high-energy workshops give dancers the opportunity to shine as they learn a Disney production number! Each ensemble receives valuable critique and learns the importance of the individual contribution to the overall success of the group, as they build toward a final performance. The students' efforts are rewarded at the end with a surprise review of their recorded pieces. Dance 101 is for all ability levels, while Dance 201 is for intermediate to advanced ensembles.

Requirements: This course has a minimum of 20 participants. No audition is necessary. Large groups may be split between two workshop locations at no additional cost. Minimum age is 11 years old for Dance 201. Please see the *Disney Performing Arts* Application and Audition Guidelines for details.

INSTRUMENTAL WORKSHOPS

Soundtrack Session: Instrumental

Instrumental students experience the excitement of a working recording studio, where professional clinicians present sight-reading techniques, performance concepts and the entire process for laying down music tracks. Taught by industry composers, arrangers, conductors or studio musicians, the 90-minute workshop culminates with a reveal of the students' hard work—a screening of their recorded score, set to the original Disney film footage!

Requirements: Created for concert bands, orchestras, and ensembles that can sight-read Grade 1 music, this course has a minimum of 30 participants. Instruments are required. Ensembles with performers ages 7-13 must provide a video submission. Please see the *Disney Performing Arts* Application and Audition Guidelines for details.

Auditions & Careers: Dance

Intermediate to advanced dance ensembles experience an audition like no other—one where the show director and choreographer critique the performances and give advice on how to land jobs as professional dancers. Once your group members are “cast,” they rehearse choreography from a Disney production and are given the tricks of the trade to make their performances sparkle. The 90-minute workshop culminates with a final performance that is recorded and reviewed by Disney professionals.

Requirements: This course has a minimum of 20 participants. Ensembles must provide a video submission. Please see the *Disney Performing Arts* Application and Audition Guidelines for details.

Dance Technique: Ballet, Hip Hop, Jazz and Tap

Designed for intermediate to advanced ensembles, these 90-minute workshops feature personalized instruction from some of the best choreographers in the world. Whether it is ballet, hip hop, jazz or tap, you choose the style for your group to concentrate on, and we take it from there. Your choreographer will customize a course to your group's skill level and create rewarding challenges for all of its dancers.

Requirements: This course has a minimum of 20 participants. Minimum age is 11 years old. Please see the *Disney Performing Arts* Application and Audition Guidelines for details.



Soundtrack Session: Jazz

Instrumental jazz students experience the excitement of a working recording studio, where industry professionals present sight-reading techniques, performance concepts, improvisational skills and the entire process for laying down music tracks. Taught by composers, arrangers, conductors or studio musicians, the 90-minute workshop culminates with a reveal of the students' hard work—a screening of their recorded score, set to the original Disney film footage!

Requirements: Created for jazz bands that can sight-read Grade 1 music, this course has a minimum of 15 participants. Instruments are required. Ensembles with performers ages 7-13 must provide a video submission. Please see the *Disney Performing Arts* Application and Audition Guidelines for details.

Disney Performing Arts Workshops

THEATRE WORKSHOPS

Acting 101

Designed for all levels of actors, this 90-minute workshop provides students with the building blocks of theatre, while exploring performance and storytelling techniques. Led by an industry show director or improvisational actor, the course focuses on tapping into the artist's unique voice, thereby discovering the tools to develop performance abilities. Students also learn to build character, develop improvisational skills and maintain professionalism on the stage.

Requirements: This course has a minimum of 15 participants. Large groups may be split between two workshop locations at no additional cost. Please see the *Disney Performing Arts* Application and Audition Guidelines for details.

Acting 201

Created for the intermediate to advanced actor, this 90-minute course challenges performers to take risks, make quick decisions, tackle cold reading material and elevate audition skills so unique talents stand out. Whether auditioning for Broadway, Disney or local theatre, the same important skills apply—and this class empowers students to shine while holding true to their voice.

Requirements: This course has a minimum of 15 participants. Large groups may be split between two workshop locations at no additional cost. Minimum age is 11 years old. Please see the *Disney Performing Arts* Application and Audition Guidelines for details.

Auditions and Careers: Musical Theatre

Intermediate to advanced musical theatre ensembles experience an audition like no other—one where the show director critiques the performances and gives advice on how to land jobs as professional musical theatre performers. Once your students are “cast,” they learn a scene from a Disney production and are shown the tricks of the trade that make performances shine.

Requirements: This course has a minimum of 20 participants. Ensembles must provide a video submission. Please see the *Disney Performing Arts* Application and Audition Guidelines for details. Minimum age is 11 years old.

Careers In Costuming

Created for high school and college theatrical costuming and fashion teams, this 90-minute interactive workshop explores the varied kinds of work to be found as a theatrical costumer or fashion designer. Led by award-winning costumers, students are shown samples of elaborate Disney costume designs and given tours of rarely seen production facilities, as they learn what it takes to become a professional in this multifaceted industry.

Requirements: This course has a minimum of 15 participants. Minimum age is 11 years old. Please see the *Disney Performing Arts* Application and Audition Guidelines for details.

Improvisational Acting

MARKETING & PLANNING

We will provide promotional materials for groups to use to help sell *Disney Youth Group Program* tickets, rooms and recreation.

Promotional Material

When designing your own materials to promote any of the *Disney Youth Programs* product lines, there are certain guidelines that must be followed relating to the use of Disney logos, photos and nomenclature. These guidelines are designed to protect the Disney name brand and to provide an equal field for all travel planners. The guidelines listed are not all-encompassing.

If you have an agreement with *Disney Youth Group Programs* for an event at *Walt Disney World Resort* and there is any conflict between the Terms and Conditions of that agreement and these guidelines, the Terms and Conditions shall prevail.

By accepting any photographs and descriptions from *Disney Youth Programs* for your use you agree to abide by the following guidelines.

PLEASE NOTE: FAILURE TO HAVE ALL COLLATERAL, VIDEOS AND WEBSITES APPROVED BY DISNEY YOUTH PROGRAMS MAY RESULT IN THE LOSS OF NET RATES.

Steps for Requesting Approval

Please send design samples to the *Disney Youth Programs* Marketing team at **least ten (10) business days before your design is scheduled to be finalized**. Promotional/collateral material may not be used unless you obtain prior written approval. **Please allow five (5) business days for feedback**. If changes must be made to your piece, the materials must be resubmitted for final written approval prior to publication or distribution. In the event that you do not receive a response from Disney to your approval request, your requested materials shall be deemed not approved. **Important! Approvals are for a single use only unless otherwise specified in our written approval**. If materials are approved by Disney for use in connection with an event to be held at *Walt Disney World Resort*, in no event shall the approved materials be used following the date of the event.

Items that must be approved include, but are not limited to, brochures, catalogs, publication advertisements, publication listings, flyers, websites and trade show booth graphics.

Social Media

Do not use images provided by Disney (photography, logos, icons, trademarks, artwork or other creative materials) on any social media/networking sites at any time with the exception of blogs which fall under the same rules and regulations as your company website. Links from social networking sites to Disney websites or Disney social networking pages may be permitted but are subject to Disney's prior review and approval.

PRINT COLLATERAL

Disney Photography, Images and Logos

Upon request, *Disney Youth Programs* will allow selected photographs, images and logos (the "Disney Materials") to be accessed and downloaded from disneyyouthtravelplanner.com.

Only Disney Materials provided and approved by *Disney Youth Programs* may be used in promotional/collateral materials or on trade show booths. (ANY photograph taken by you, your participants or other non-Disney affiliated individuals may not be used except in your company social media sites. (i.e. Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, etc.)

All Disney Materials must contain the Disney copyright notice ©Disney (not italicized in this case) directly below the item.

Beyond the materials provided by Disney, no other Disney trademarks, images, logos or artwork depicting Disney scenes or Characters may be used in your promotional/collateral materials.

Characters, Artwork and Disney Elements
Disney Characters and Character art MAY NOT be used in any form! This includes outlines of Mickey Mouse ears, hands, etc. In addition, artwork or illustrations produced by a non-Disney-licensed artist or not provided to you by *Disney Youth Programs* that depict or suggest Disney scenes and/or logos are not permitted. **Photographs taken by you or any of your participants may not be used.**

Placement of Disney Images and Elements

The materials you produce must clearly be a sales tool for your company and may not appear as a Disney promotion or advertisement. **Your company name, logo or other images must be 20% larger than any Disney element or reference.**

Wording or layout may not imply or state an exclusive relationship or an endorsement by *Disney Youth Programs, The Walt Disney Company, or any of its related or affiliated companies.*

It is preferred that Disney Materials appear on a page by itself.

If you are promoting more than one travel destination on a page, the Disney Materials must be equal to, but not greater than, the size of any non-Disney Material(s). Approvals for this type of layout are more complicated and will be determined on a case-by-case basis.

Art or copy may not run across any Disney Materials (except for copyright information). The Disney Materials may not be altered in any way. Logos may only appear in

a black-and-white format or in the specified PMS colors provided to you by *Disney Youth Programs*. Any use of the logos for *Festival Disney, The Disney Honors, Disney Youth Tickets, Disney Youth Education Series, Disney Performing Arts OnStage, Disney Performing Arts Workshops, Disney Gospel Choir Fest, Disney Grad Nite* and *Walt Disney World Resort* must use the words:

No Disney Materials can be used on the Internet or on a website by a non-Disney entity without the prior written permission of *Disney Youth Programs*. All of the above mentioned guidelines regarding images/logos apply.

A Hotlink connecting your website to Disney's website is subject to approval by Disney. A Hotlink from a Disney website back to your website is not permitted.

Trade Show Graphics

Disney Materials or other Disney items purchased in a store or received from a Disney representative (other than Disney Materials provided by *Disney Youth Programs* specifically for this use) may not be placed in your booth.

Specialty Merchandise

VIDEO MATERIALS

Steps for Requesting Approval

If interested in producing a Sales video, you may request existing Disney B-roll footage to be provided to you from *Disney Youth Programs*. Please contact *Disney Youth Programs* regarding your request.

STEP 1: Prior to creating your video, you must apply to Disney for a clip license. This agreement will permit use of Disney-provided footage. To request a clip license, please contact *Disney Youth Programs*.

STEP 2: When submitting your clip license request, you must include a proposed program script specifically outlining usage of the requested Disney footage. The script must include all specifics (e.g., audio script and visual description including name, date, time, location, etc.) of the information to be covered in the video.

STEP 3: Submit a rough cut of the video to *Disney Youth Programs* before proceeding with the final production.

STEP 4: Prior to duplicating, distributing, or exhibiting the finished video, a copy must be submitted to *Disney Youth Programs* for final review and approval. Please allow at least **five (5) business days for each phase's review and approval**. Approval may be withheld at the sole discretion of *Disney Youth Programs*. In the event that you do not receive a response from Disney to your request for approval, your requested materials shall be deemed not approved.

Disney Video Footage

Include a trademark symbol (e.g., ® or ™), as indicated in the subsequent pages showing nomenclature examples, once per mark per page. In subsequent usage on the same page, the registered trademark symbol is not necessary, but can appear if preferred*.

*A registration symbol must be used each time with Epcot®, Disney's Hollywood Studios®, Disney® Resort, Disney® Park and Disney California Adventure® Park.
